# **News in Brief**

We're delighted to report that volunteers have come forward to act as Voluntary Flood Wardens. Thank you to those who have committed to this scheme.

We have been notified by East Riding of Yorkshire Council of planned surface dressing to roads in Wilberfoss – namely, the Hull Road, Moorfield Drive, Moorfield Way and Windmill Meadows. We have notified East Riding of Yorkshire Council that Moorfield Way has been re-surfaced and we have asked that Hawthorn Drive be added to the scheme.

Please use the template letter we have uploaded to the News page of the parish website to campaign for additional bus services through the village.

There is currently a 10-week consultation on changes to council ward boundaries. Residents are being encouraged to have their say. You'll find details on the News page of the parish website.

We will be progressing a scheme to add an additional access point to the amenity land on Storking Lane.

A resent has shared their concern about children cycling straight out of the snicket onto Middle Street. Delivery drivers in particular will be unaware of the concealed entrance so please remind your children about the need for caution. There are cyclist dismount signs displayed and we will approach East Riding of Yorkshire Council to see whether any additional safety measures can be considered.




