News in Brief

The embankment on Becksid e will be re-seeded again in due course and the bollards will be installed. We have been provided with a printout of the bank profile which shows that the level is no lower, and in places is higher, than the original embankment level.

Stamford Bridge - Bridge Repairs Wilberfoss Parish Council approached East Riding of Yorkshire Council for a temporary traffic light system to one of the junctions of the village to assist in accessing the A1079 during the works. The Senior Project Manager's response was as follows

The reason for traffic lights at High Catton is that it is likely to be the most heavily used diversion for people and is notoriously difficult to exit onto the A1079 due to bends and curvature of sight lines.

The junctions at Wilberfoss are much more sympathetic for exit with good site lines, the flows are likely to be reduced due to the escort and traffic lights at A1079, Hayton. I would also like to minimise the amount of traffic lights on the route.

Sadly, my project does not have the budget to install traffic lights at all junctions along the A1079 and the High Catton junction takes priority in this case.

I will however monitor the situation which can evolve during the closure period.

We have been informed that in addition to this disruption, carriageway patching repairs

will be carried out on the A1079 at Wilberfoss but we haven't been given a start date.

We have submitted a pre-planning enquiry for the bus shelter on Main Street (opposite Willow Park Road). The wheels move slowly!

We're delighted to advise that our £500 bid for funding from the D-Day 80 Community Fund has been successful! The funds will contribute towards the cost of this year's Elders Party which is taking place on Sunday 2nd June and is celebrating this historic anniversary. So far, 60 senior residents have signed up. We hope everyone has a wonderful afternoon of live entertainment and refreshments!

Painting of the village bridges will start this month.

Can we please ask parents to remind children not to trespass on landowners' private property. We received a photograph of children running over a farmer's newly planted potato field. With the winter we've experienced it is a particularly distressing time for landowners who rely on crops for their livelihoods. Growing up in a rural environment is special but needs to be respectful. Thanks.

We have received one application for the current vacancies. If you're interested in getting involved in our community, do get in touch as we still have one vacancy for a Parish Councillor remaining.

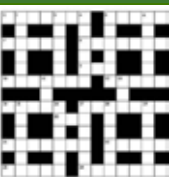

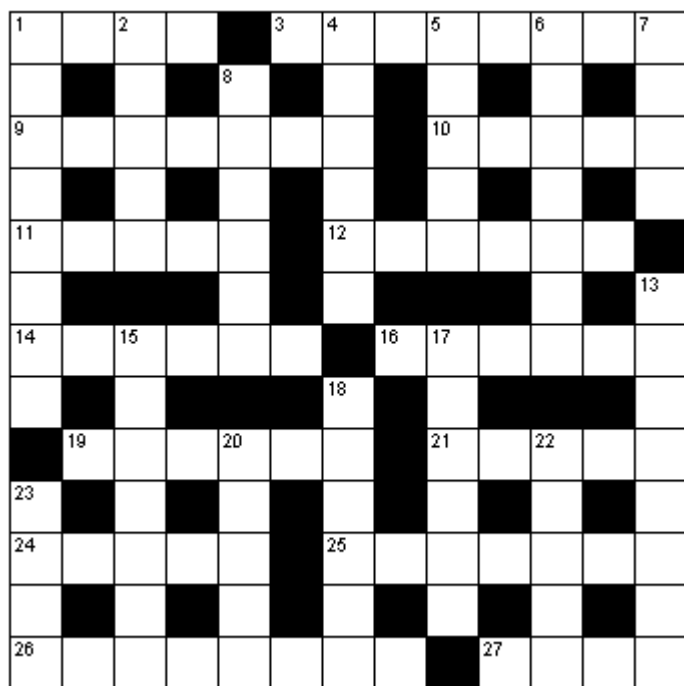
